# Newsflash

The M/V Pacific Hope has just arrived on the Amazon River for a three month stay. The vessel will reach deep into the Amazon Region carrying medical teams, medical supplies, community development teams and equipment, government officials, and returning native tribal people to their villages.



Last month, the third Marine Reach Discipleship Bible School students graduated with their certificates.

The three-month long, intensive bible study and training program is a passion-project for husband and wife leaders, Silas and Amy Bauer. This couple both participated in DBS's as students several years ago, and then brought their experiences to Marine Reach to pioneer the program here in Tauranga.

Staffing their first school together, they fell in love, and were married in January of 2021. Since then, they've led two additional DBS's and enjoyed getting to share their awe and delight in studying the bible with others. They've worked with several additional DBS staff team members to invest intentionally into the lives and growth of this recent student class.

A key focus of the Discipleship Bible School is the overarching story of the Bible and the character portrait of God that is evident in seeing the scope of scripture. Another focus is reading the bible closely in its historical context, with the goal of allowing the scriptures to disciple the reader.

Reflecting on this school, Amy shares: "During the prayer and preparation for this DBS we felt God tell us that our students would become Established in the Word of God. Many of our students are new believers, they've never read the Bible before, and it has been an incredible privilege to help them build a firm foundation for their faith."

Linda Cowie recognized the need to equip the next generation to step into leadership roles within the ministry. This prompted a process of championing a new organisational structure.

One vital role that developed during that restructuring was that of a Base Director. For Marine Reach, that role was filled by Daniel Snyder starting in 2018.

Dan's day-to-day life changes depending on what is happening that week, but the overall theme of his job is to facilitate smooth operations in the present while keeping the ministry's goals for the future in mind.

Dan convenes the Base Leadership Team, providing spiritual oversight and vision for the ministry, as well as the LIFE Team, which oversees the base logistics and supports the BLT with pastoral care. In these roles, he champions other staff, oversees a variety of financial and legal areas, troubleshoots in areas of both spiritual and practical needs, and encourages sound decision-making and implementation of plans. Dan supplements his Base Director schedule with occasional teachings on the schools and supporting the Pilgrimage DTS in the October Quarter.

# The Adventure of a **Lifetime Opportunity!**


Vanuatu's borders will open to international travellers at the beginning of July 2022! The Family Care Centre, located outside Port Vila on Efate Island, is eager to welcome internationals back to the ministry.

For the past two years, the FCC has been running medical and dental clinics, providing spiritual training, and meeting needs of the community through practical service. This has been accomplished through the grace of God and a dedicated, remnant team of staff that were in Vanuatu when the borders closed along with new, local staff after the DTS last year.

While the FCC staff have done an incredible job of maintaining an active ministry and presence within the NiVan community around them, there are many gaps on the team that are ready to be filled.

The volunteer staff needs are diverse, so whatever your skill set and experience, there is likely a place for you! Specifically, the FCC is actively recruiting volunteers to serve in:

Food Services: this role includes meal planning, food shopping, cooking, budgeting, and schedule building (such as dishes, cooking teams, etc). Feeding people is a demonstration of the heart of hospitality, and in Vanuatu, hospitality is a powerful way to connect with locals.

Maintenance: this role includes a wide variety of tasks to help keep the FCC campus running smoothly, such as electrical, plumbing, gas stoves, water heaters, appliances, and general repairs. An excellent person for this position would be a "jack of all trades" self learner that enjoys creative problem solving!

**Medical/Dental Professionals:** the FCC clinic runs both a dental clinic as well as a medical clinic, and therefore the need is great for people trained specifically in these areas. Dentists, doctors, nurses, dental assistants, and others with certifications or backgrounds in meeting people's physical health needs could play a vital role in meeting the needs of the local community.


