The Discipleship Training School start date is 25 July 2022. This five-month long training program is open to anyone wishing to be discipled and trained in the ways

of following Jesus and living out their faith in their own life. It includes three-months of lectures located in Tauranga, and two-months of outreach application.

The Discipleship Bible School start date is 23 July 2022. This three-month long program is open to DTS graduates who desire to read and study the Bible, and gain a richer understanding of the scope and purpose of Scripture. It takes place at the Marine Reach base in Tauranga, and students can opt to participate in an additional 1-month outreach to apply their learning.

We are excited to embark on a new season of hosting international schools after the hiatus of the past two years, and if participating in a DTS or DBS is something you have thought about doing, now is a great time to pursue that dream!

Marine Reach Global Welcomes Barbados to the Family

Marine Reach Global, the sister-ministry of Marine Reach which among other things, oversees the M/V Pacific Hope doing relief work in the Caribbean and South America, has been experiencing a season of new beginnings.

In early 2020, MR Global acquired the use of a YWAM base in Barbados. This campus is situated in the south-east of the island, a short distance from the coast. Equipped with accommodations to host DTS's, youth camps, and long term staff, the campus's partnership with Marine Reach Global is an incredible opportunity to have a long term, land-based home for the ministry. However, as the pandemic grew, so did the restrictions for travel, and Barbados experienced a long lockdown.

During that time, though, the Barbados campus staff were able to creatively continue their calling to disciple young people by hosting online vacation camps as well as engaging the nearby communities with regular visits to pray and distribute bibles. They also used the time to focus on improving the facilities and property in order to be poised to welcome students, visitors, and ministry opportunities back onto campus as soon as restrictions were lifted.

As usual during hurricane season in the Caribbean, some storms caused damage in the region, so there was plenty of clean up and repairs to be completed. With the skilled hands of many volunteers who chose to serve in Barbados, the campus was able to get ready for a busy summer of ministry. During this year, the Barbados campus will be running its first DTS since the pandemic, as well as restarting youth camps on campus.

Base Directors Rob and Christine Lucerne share: "When M/V Pacific Hope and S/Y Next Wave were docked in Barbados for a few weeks last year, crew and staff got to know each other and had a blast despite Covid! Now we can't wait to be involved 'hands on' with the Pacific Hope, currently in the Amazon region. In September, our 'Amazon Adventure DTS' will join the ship for outreach, supporting and serving to bring medical aid, the Gospel and Bibles to the unreached - what a thrill!"

FCC Clinic Update

It has been an interesting season at the Family Care Centre Clinic!

However, despite several months of community transmission of covid, some staff changes, and the FCC having a heavier than usual patient load for a bit due to Port Vila hospital redirecting all noncovid care to community clinics, the Family Care Centre clinic has continued to remain open to serve the needs of the community.

For several weeks, the FCC was experiencing a high number of patients seeking care due to the Port Vila hospital being closed to non-covid patients. This led to a greater variety of symptoms and needs coming through the doors than usual.

Additionally, the staff transition of longtime FCC nurse Melissa Johnny returning to New Zealand shortly after experienced FCC nurses Anna Harris and Estera Badulescu were able to return to Vanuatu after extended border closure related absences has only increased the sense of readjusting to a new normal for the time being.

On clinic days, staff may see symptoms of coughs, address wound care needs, provide exercises to relieve musculoskeletal pain, conduct antenatal checkups, perform hypertension or diabetes checkup, or identify respiratory infections.

Nurse Estera shares, "Sometimes, for us as nurses, it seems a lot because we not only see patients in the consult but also we have to organise the teams in triage, dental care and others managing jobs. But the Lord is taking care of each one of us and this ministry. The provincial health system sent us a new nurse assistant to help us with the amount of work we have and we are blessed to see improvement in our relationships with them.

Despite the changes required to adapt to the current clinic life, God is continuing to use the FCC: Recently, a man from the neighbourhood came in with ongoing bilateral knee pain.

With the resources available, the clinic could not do much for him, but the Lord touched his knee in the consult room and after praying several times, he came out of the clinic able to walk without help.

Testimonies like this fill up our spirits with expectations to see what the Lord has in store for the future.


