Wild Heart Takes On Youth

The Wild Heart DTS Stream is focused on what it looks like to pursue God with a heart on fire for Him, encouraging students to go after a relationship with God like those in the bible who were radically obedient: Moses, David, Deborah etc.

Last month, the Wild Heart stream students and staff helped out at a youth retreat weekend for eighteen Palmerston North youth between the ages of 12 and 18.

After finishing lectures covering the topics of the Father Heart of God, Authority and Submission, the Character and Nature of God, and Hearing God's Voice, the 12 students and staff loaded up in vans and drove two and a half hours to join the youth from St Alberns, located in Palmerston North.

The goal for their time with the youth was to see them go deeper with the Lord, receiving personal revelations of who He is. Collectively, this was done through teachings by the DTS staff and students on Surrender, Lordship, and Wholehearted Obedience, as well as spurring the youth on to pursue God by sharing words of encouragement and scriptures with them.



One of the highlights from the weekend was the Saturday night ministry time, in which youth had the opportunity to write down things they felt to surrender to God, and then symbolically burn the paper.

Kaitlyn Rodley, one of the Wild Heart staff, reflects on the weekend: "It was beautiful to see change in the youth, even after such a short time with them. God started some deep works and it felt so special to have been a messenger of what He wanted to say to them."

The Wild Heart Stream will be finishing up their lecture phase along with the rest of the DTS, and will leave for outreach mid October.

Please pray for the DTS students and staff: that God would be working mightily in their lives, as well as through them as they continue to invest in others throughout outreach.





In August 2019, Douglas and Juliana Lyra boarded a flight from Brazil with high hopes of serving the Lord as missionaries. Although they knew they were starting a new chapter, they certainly didn't know what the next few years would involve!

The couple knew a family already working with YWAM in New Zealand, and they moved to Tauranga with intentions to increase their English fluency and attend a Discipleship Training School at Marine Reach. Prior to the start date of their October DTS, they flew to Vanuatu and served at the FCC. With Juliana's education and experience as a dentist, she was able to offer support in the clinic. Douglas, ever ready to jump into whatever project needs to be tackled, helped with grounds, maintenance, and cooking..

Juliana and Douglas completed their DTS, participating in an outreach to Fiji where they were able to put their respective experiences and skills to work, and then they joined staff at Marine Reach. They were both able to complete the first Discipleship Bible School at Marine Reach in 2020, and then went on to staff the October 2020 school.

Since April 2021, Douglas has been serving in the media department at Marine Reach. Starting 24 October 2022, he will be coordinating a 4-week intensive School of Media on how to use media, such as photography, videography, and social media, as both a ministry to build connection with others and as a tool to share God's stories with excellence.

Juliana has been managing the Marine Reach kitchen since the beginning of 2022, frequently cooking delicious meals and coordinating teams to fulfil kitchen duties such as dishes and meal prep.

The Lyra's son, Davi, born in September 2021, is a true YWAM baby! He has learned to crawl on the Marine Reach lounge floor, cheerfully waves hello and goodbye to any number of students and staff, and generally brings joy and delight to all who spend time with him.


We are so thankful for this family and their faithful, versatile service at Marine Reach over the past three years! They tirelessly serve behind the scenes to


